Tá sé céad bliain ó mharaigh na Black and tans 14 daoine, a bhí ag féachaint ar an chluiche pile I bPáirc an Chrócaigh, idir Baile Áth Cliath agus Tiobrad Arann.

D'fhás ár Daideo Deiric suas sa chenaatr sin agus d'imir sé le O' Tooles nuair a bhí sé óg. Bhí a Dhaid Lar mar réiteoir ar an an 50ú chómoradh 50 bliain ó shin. Tháinig na saighdiuirí go dtí an chluiche agus thosaigh siad ag scaoileadh pileir agus mharaigh siad a lán daoine. Caithfimid smaoineamh ar na

daoine seo an seachtain seo agus bheith brodúil as ár gcluichí féin. It's 100 years this week since Bloody Sunday happened. Our grandfather Derek grew up beside Croke Park and played with O' Tooles when he was younger and some of his club members played for Dublin that day, when the Black and Tans surrounded Croke park and shot 14 people dead, including Michael

Hogan the footballer. This is where the name The Hogan Stand comes from. Our great grandfather was the referee for the 50th anniversary match and on that day Finbarr's played the curtain raiser and Muinteoir Marianne's father was coaching the team. We should all be very proud of playing our native games.

Tipperary went onto win the All Ireland football final that year to honour those killed on Bloody Sunday and they haven't won it since. Maybe this year.....
